WHAT WAS THE ORIGIN OF THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS ESTABLISHED BY THE UN?

In July 2015, UN member countries reached an agreement on world goals. The purpose of the agreement was to commit work and energy to ensuring that people throughout the world could live better, without damaging the planet. The states would work to attain these goals for the next 15 years, from 2016 to 2030.

These goals are referred to as the Sustainable Development Goals, or in summary as the SDGs. There are different types: to end poverty, to achieve universal education.... But in 'Hazlo Verde!' we obviously want you to work with us in particular on those goals related to sustainability and care of the environment.

Although great progress has been made, there is still a lot of work to do. The aim of the goals is to provide concrete solutions to the big challenges today's world is facing, but we can only achieve this with the help of people from the entire planet, people like you, your family, teachers, the community and—above all—the boys and girls, **because the present belongs to everyone, but the future belongs to them, the children, because they are the root.**
